9. **VENUE:**

The 2006 Division One/Premier Amateur Night Series will be hosted by the Queens Park (Coker Park). No alcohol is to be brought into the venue. Only alcohol brought from the club bar may be consumed inside the venue.

10. **CLUB INFRINGEMENTS:**

Club teams that do not strictly adhere to the Rules of the Competition may incur a fine, which will be determined by Football West.

11. **WITHDRAWAL OF TEAMS:**

Football West shall have the power to impose a fine to a maximum of \$2,000.00, or to withdraw any team(s) and substitute another, if it is considered necessary at any stage of the competition for any of the following reasons:-

12. **PLAYERS / INSURANCE / REGISTRATION:**

Only players registered with Football West through their respective clubs will be eligible to play. All clubs must send to the Football West office prior to the first game a list of players (**Players List attached**) to be registered along with the payment for each player listed. Once a player features on this players list the club must pay their registration prior to 1 April 2006.

13. **REPLACEMENT OF PLAYERS – RULES OF THE GAME:**

- a) Any player who has been substituted cannot take any further part in the game, including any extra time.
- b) Any player ordered off the field by a Referee of play cannot be replaced.
- c) A maximum of (16) players are to be named on the match card, with the substitute players being listed as substitutes.

14. **TEAM SHEETS AND TEAM LISTS FOR MEDIA:**

- a) It will be the responsibility for each club to provide a Manager with a properly completed team sheet showing clearly the names and numbers of participating players and their designation as either player or substitute (see above). **Minimum 15 minutes prior to start of game.**

Squad lists must be provided to the Service Provider 1 week prior to each fixture for use in any competition programmes. A fine of \$150 per club will be given to any club failing to provide this detail.

- b) Any clubs whose team sheet doesn't match the team list with program will incur a \$50.00 fine per player, after the first offence.

**15. ELIGIBLE PLAYERS:**

All players registered with their respective clubs.

**16. SUBSTITUTIONS**

a) Up to a maximum of three substitutes may be used in any match Played in an official competition organised under the auspices of FIFA, the Confederations or the National Associations.

b) Five (5) substitutes on the team sheet, maximum of three (3) can play.

**17. CONTROL OF GAMES AREA:**

The entire playing area shall be under the control of the host club and his/her Security Staff.

**18. REFEREES AND ASSISTANT REFEREES:**

a) The Soccer Australia Referees (WA) Inc. Perth Branch and Metro West Allocation Committees shall appoint all referees.

**19. REFEREE'S FEES:**

Both clubs playing must pay 50% of the referees fees on the night.

Referee: \$70.00  
Assistant: \$35.00 per assistant

**20. ENTRY FEES (If Applicable):**

Adults	\$6.00	Inclusive of GST
Pensioners/ Students	\$4.00	Inclusive of GST

**21. COMPETITION RULES:**

**Group Rounds**

- The 12 teams will be placed into 2 groups of 6.
- In the event of two teams finishing the group rounds with equal points, equal goal difference, then the team with the best result in matches between the two teams concerned shall be awarded the higher placing.
- Should teams have the same goal difference, then the team having scored the highest number of goals will be placed in the higher position.
- If the teams have the same goals for, the team with the least amount of disciplinary points against will go forward.

- Should clubs still be level, a penalty shoot out will be played to determine the team that progresses/wins or a coin toss (TBA).
- Disciplinary points will be 1 point for a yellow card and 2 points for a red card.

- \* **Matches will be played in double-headers across an 8-week period.**

#### **Semi-Finals**

- The teams that finish first and second from each group will progress to semi-finals.
- Matches will be played as a double-header across 1 week.

#### **Finals**

- Losers of each semi-final will play for 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> place
- Winners of each semi-final will play for 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place
- Matches will be played as a double-header across 1 week.

#### **22. DRAWN GAMES:**

##### **Semi Finals & Finals:**

- If at the end of full-time the result is a draw, then two (2) periods of extra time of 15 minutes each way will be played.
- If at the conclusion of (a) the results are still tied, then the result will be decided by a penalty shootout as per the FIFA Rules (five penalties for each team, and then sudden death) Penalty Shoot-outs.

#### **23. PRESENTATIONS:**

No club or individual may present any trophy, medallion, prize money, balls or any other form of presentation during the competition except with the permission of the Football West Board.

**24. SECURITY STAFF/CLUB OFFICIALS:**

Service Provider to provide 4 security staff and each team participating on game night must provide 1 additional club official during their match.

**25. PRIZE MONEY/EQUIPMENT:**

Winner            \$1,000.00

This will be paid subject to the sponsorship being received and honoured.

**26. AMENDMENT TO RULES:**

- b) The Football West Board shall make amendments to these Rules where and when necessary.
- c) Such rules will be circulated to all participating clubs.
- d) The decision will be final and binding.

**27. MEDIA FACILITIES / PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEM**

This will be the responsibility of the Service Provider.

**28. PENALTIES & FINES**

All monies due from penalties and fines will be payable to Football West.

**29. ANY OTHER ISSUES**

If any issue is not covered within these Rules of Competition at time of commencement of the series, then the League Rules of Competition or Football West Regulations shall apply (as current at the beginning of the series). Football West will determine the outcome of any issue not covered in these Rules and Regulations.

However, any issue or dispute that can't reasonably be determined prior to the next round date of the series will be determined by Football West.

Football West decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
