Offence Details

Offence Number	6(7) of the Rules of Competition
Offence Description	Player plays in fixture whilst ineligible (note there was no appeal with respect to the 5(2) breach earlier imposed by the Grievance Panel).

Appeal Outcome

Finding	<p>The panel made note of the provisions contained within article 55 of the FIFA Disciplinary Code which provides that if a player takes part in an official match despite being ineligible, his team will be sanctioned by forfeiting the match and payment of a fine. The panel acknowledges the application of FIFA laws as the framework over which FFA and Football West laws must operate.</p> <p>The Rules of Competition place a clear obligation on each club to ensure that each player who actually participates in a match is eligible to do so, and whilst acknowledging the human error, this has clearly not occurred here.</p>
Penalty	Appeal of Sorrento Football Club is upheld. ECU Joondalup forfeit the match 3-0.
