

**Annexe 2**

**All Flags Finals Series**

## Article 1 - General

---

1. The All Flags Finals Series is a continuation of the regular season.
2. All rules contained within the Football West Competition Rules and Annexe 1 of those rules are valid for the All Flags Finals Series unless otherwise specified in this document.
3. Where a rule in the Football West Competition Rules or Annexe 1 of those rules appears to conflict with these rules, the rule in this document takes precedence.
4. Only a club which does not have an outstanding debt with Football West will be eligible to win prize money.
5. A player may not appear on the team list of a team in the All Flags Finals Series if he has appeared on the team list for a different club earlier in the same finals series.

## Article 2 - Competition Format

---

1. The teams which occupy the top 5 positions of the Premier Division following the completion of the regular season will compete in a All Flags Finals Series.

2. The fixtures of the All Flags Finals Series will be structured as follows:

### **Week 1**

Fixture A	Team finishing 4th vs Team finishing 5th	Losing team eliminated
Fixture B	Team finishing 2nd vs Team finishing 3rd	

### **Week 2**

Fixture C	Loser Fixture B vs Winner Fixture A	Losing team eliminated
Fixture D	Team finishing 1st vs Winner Fixture B	

### **Week 3**

Fixture E	Loser Fixture D vs Winner Fixture C	Losing team eliminated
-----------	-------------------------------------	------------------------

### **Week 4**

Fixture F	Winner Fixture D vs Winner Fixture E	Losing team eliminated

3. In weeks 1, 2 and 3, each fixture will be conducted at the home venue of the team named first in the fixture list described in paragraph 2, unless otherwise arranged by the home club and agreed by Football West. Football West will determine the date and time of the fixture in consultation with the home club.
4. Fixture F in week 4 will be conducted at a venue, date and time determined by Football West.
5. Should scores be level at the full-time whistle, extra time of two equal periods of 15 minutes will be played in accordance with the procedures to determine the winner of match as described in the FIFA Laws of the Game.



## **Article 5 - Match Balls**

---

1. The host club will provide the match balls for all fixtures, including the Reserves and 18s matches, except the finals. Football West will supply all match balls for the finals.

## **Article 6 - Admission**

---

1. A maximum of 20 people from each visiting team will be provided with a free entry pass to the venue for any one match day for use by the players, club officials or a club's official guests only. The visiting clubs must inform the host club in writing the names to be granted free entry by noon on the last working day prior to the fixture.
2. Should Fixture F be held at a neutral venue, all teams will be provided with a maximum of 25 free entry passes.

## **Article 7 - Squad Lists**

---

1. Football West reserves the right to request a squad list for each competing team in a fixture. If requested, such a list must be provided in writing 4 business days prior to the fixture.
