Extract from National Registration Regulations (NRR) Article 3.3 / Page 7

3.3 Reacquisition of Amateur Status

a) A Player registered as a Professional cannot re-register as an Amateur until at least 30 days after his or her last Match as a Professional. Acknowledging that Australia has only one Competition involving full time Professional and the different Season timings between Football Federation Australia (FFA) and Member Federation (Football West) Competitions, Competition Rules may provide an exception to allow a Professional in the A-League to return to a Competition as an Amateur with a shorter stand down period.

b) No compensation is payable on the reacquisition of Amateur status. If a Player re-registers as a Professional within 30 months of being reinstated as an Amateur, then Training Compensation may be paid, if applicable, in accordance with Article 10 – Training Compensation (Page 27 of the NRR).
