<b>State League Standing Committee Recommendation</b> Player eligibility for Top four Cup to be restricted for Reserves and 18's competitions. Only allow players that have played 50% of the games for that grade to be eligible for Top 4 Cup. Unless the Player is playing up from a lower grade or has not played in the higher grade. If a player has played First Team or Reserves, he must have played 50% of Reserves or 18's games to be eligible to play in Reserves or 18's Top 4 Cup. Players can play up a grade without restriction.

<b>Reasons for Decision</b> Football West agrees with the recommendation restrict player eligibility to protect the integrity of the State League 18s and Reserves Top 4 Cups. This has been enacted in the Competition Rules. The new competition rule is: A Player who has played in multiple age groups for a particular State League Team in his Club is ineligible to participate in any Top Four Cup Matches in a lower age group than the highest age group Team for which he has played, unless they have played 50% or more of their Matches for a lower age group..
