- PSA match fees will be invoiced directly to the PSA / School (subject to an additional 10% GST).
- All other match fees (including Amateur Cup with two Premier teams) are to be paid in cash directly to the referee(s) prior to the match, with each team to pay 50% of the total match fee listed above.
- Friendly matches (5 days' notice) and tournaments/carnivals (28 days' notice) require completion of necessary request forms. Tournaments/carnivals involve an additional administrative fee.
