


How to build your teams

After signing into Squadi admin HERE

Step 1: Select the Home icon in the top right then select the Registration module




Step 2. Hover over the Registrations tab then select Football Australia Registrations




Step 3. Here you will see all of your organisations registrations from PlayFootball. You will need to move these users to their respective competitions.

To do this use the filters to narrow down your selection, then **Individually Select** or **Multi Select** the user/s and then select **Move** in the top right




Step 4: Then select the **Year**, **Competition**, **Affiliate**, **Role** and **Age Group** the user/s will move into


Repeat this process for all of yours users roles Players, Managers, Coaches and Team Officials to be added into teams



Step 5. Select the **Teams** module via the main navigation in the top right




Step 6. Select the correct Competition and Age Group in the top bar of filters



Step 7. Individually Select or **Multi-select** users from the left hand side, then **hold** and **drag** into their team on the right hand side

By default the list of participants will only show those not in a team. You can toggle this on/off and also use the filtering or search option to narrow this list.




Once the users have been assigned into their team, you can then see the total count for each role and can select the **number count** to see a summary view

P = Players


C = Coaches

M = Managers


O = Team Officials



You can make any changes and unassign participants by selecting **unassign** and **save**. This will then populate them back onto participant list on the left hand side



You can also move users age groups by selecting the **user**, then selecting **actions** and **change age groups**



Once you've completed this for each competition and age group, you have completed the team building process
